3. Bugs fixed with this PTF Release

- 14653 Accepting/Declining an appointment in OL2007 generates "changed appointment" mails
The fix adds fields to ignore to the algorithm trying to detect changes in an appointment. So the changed appointments notifications are suppressed.
No possible side effects.
- 17709 Several strings not translated to Japanese
The fix only corrects the wrong value for the Japanese name of the SPAM and INBOX folder.
No possible side effects.
- 17783 Very slow performance in OX6 Infostore after latest updates in large contexts.
Optimized some mysql queries to speed up the infostore module.
No possible side effects.
- 17890 Later added external participants receive emails without accept/decline buttons
The fix adds the iCal invitation attachment to mails for external participants.
No possible side effects.
- 17915 Infostore broken at
"com.openexchange.consistency.Consistency\$CreateInfoitem"
Adjusted the file storage implementation to supply the correct list of files.
No possible side effects.
- 18000 updating on RHEL and SLES does not work
Fixed a bug in the postinstall section of the specfile.
No possible side effects.
- 18045 Double-Click on Mail Attachments should open Online Office with selected File
Adjusting the customer plug in to not open the browser file dialog.
No possible side effects.
