MySQL seems to have a problem under certain circumstances to generate proper unique identifier. Unfortunately this can cause a drop of a long existing database schema filled with a lot of contexts. The fix takes care of this and does not drop the schema anymore. Additionally another method is used to create proper unique identifier. No potential side effects.
