## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #4174.

#### 54728 After deletion of guard, encrypted emails generate confusing messages

After deleting guard for a user and sending him an encrypted email "I dont remember receiving a "initial" password. There is no seperate email I received." was displayed.

Now new keys will be created without the "initial" password.

## 3 Changes relevant for Operators

### 3.1 Changes of Configuration Files

# Change #4290 Add configuration setting to specify the MAIL FROM used in the SMTP Envelope

The following Configuration Setting is added

- # SMTP Server MAIL FROM
- # When sending an email using the guestSMTPServer, Guard

will use the configured email Address

- # for the MAIL FROM in the SMTP envelope
- # If blank, the senders address will be used

com.openexchange.guard.guestSMTPMailFrom=

This address will be used in the SMTP envelope when sending to/from Guest users

#### 4 Tests

Open-Xchange has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behaviour. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
