## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #1899.

### **23141 Files in /var/spool/open-xchange/uploads/ are not deleted when groupware is stopped**

The request failed due to too much request parameters. While adding these request parameters to an internal map a RuntimeException is thrown and therefore the uploaded files are not remembered. This causes the clean up method to not find any uploaded files to purge.

This has been fixed by reordering the code to remember the uploaded files even if the request fails due to too much parameters.

### **31302 Configuration of external email accounts via autoconfig not working properly**

No reasonable connect timeout was set when checking connectivity to mail/transport servers when operating in "guess" mode.

Solution description: Specify a reasonable connect timeout was set when checking connectivity to mail/transport servers. Moreover several other improvements were performed; e.g also consider '587' as alternative SMTP default port.

## 3 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All bug fixes have been checked for potential side effects and changed behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
