2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2732.

40641 Video stream breaks on Firefox

When using Firefox to participate at a video conference, the stream could crash after a couple of minutes. This has been solved.

40134 Audio conference limitation

Group voice communication was limited to five participants. This limit has been lifted.

39990 Call duration time shown incorrectly

After ending a call, the call initiator has gotten incorrect call duration information. This has been solved.

36568 Call drops when switching apps

When switching applications while performing video or audio calls using flash-fallback, there is a possibility that the call drops and the video stream stutters. This has been solved by enhancing the integration of the Flash component.

3 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
