1 Objective of this Document


This document provides an overview of the minor new features coming out in the OX Guard v2.2.0 release.

The objective of this document is to help Open-Xchange customers and partners understand the logic behind these features and changes, especially the reason for enhancements in usability.

2 OX Guard v2.2.0 with OX App Suite v7.8.0

2.1 Support of new mail compose dialog

OX App Suite v7.8.0 bring with it a new OX Mail web frontend. This includes changes to the mail compose dialog and general behavior within the app. As with 7.6.0, 7.6.1 and 7.6.2, this new design aims to deliver a higher level of conformance with common practice and end-user habits. For example consider the image below:



Due to new design changes implemented in OX App Suite v7.8.0, OX Guard has now been brought inline with this new compose window. This means the repositioning of the 'Lock' icon and the addition of a new dropdown link called "Security".

2.2 Guided Tour for OX Guard

Together with OX App Suite v7.8.0 this new minor release provides a new guided tour that explain all necessary steps a user needs to perform to encrypt mails and files.

The guided tour can be triggered from within the OX Mail and OX Drive apps. It is also available from the user settings within OX Guard. The following information will be provided:

- The Guard module in general: Security and privacy matters to everyone.
- How to create an account: Choose a password that will be used to encrypt or decrypt items.
- Guard Security Settings: How to change encryption password or request a temporary password
- Information about all possible encryption and decryption settings
- Information about the advanced settings such as PGP Public Keys
- How to remove encryptions
